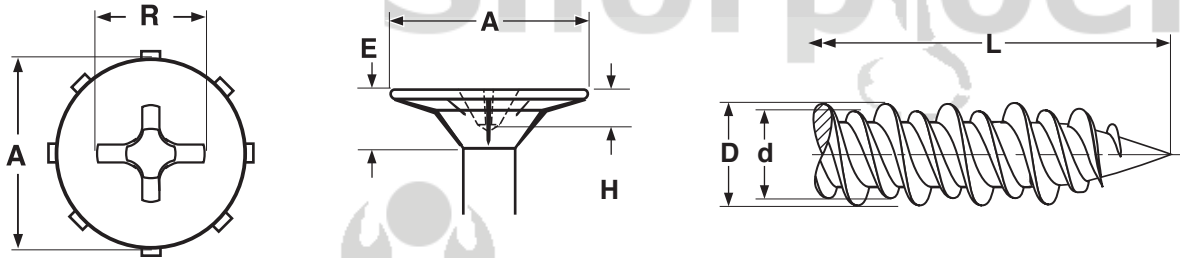


**Wafer Head with Nibs HIGH-LOW SCREWS, SHARP POINT**

**NOTE:** Four long and four short nibs alternate around the underside of the Wafer head.

<b>Description</b>	A countersunk fastener with a flat head, 30° angled sharp point, and a double-lead, consisting of a high and low thread. The lower thread has a total diameter that is 30% to 50% less than the total diameter of the high thread. Eight equidistant nibs are on the underside of the head. Four long nibs that extend from the top edge to the shank alternate with four shorter nibs. The ceramic coating resists corrosion.
<b>Applications/ Advantages</b>	For attaching cement board to wood studs. Screw should embed itself into the wood material at least 1/2 inch.
<b>Material</b>	AISI 1018-1022 or equivalent steel
<b>Heat Treatment</b>	Screws shall be quenched in liquid and then tempered by reheating.
<b>Surface Hardness</b>	Vickers HV 450 minimum
<b>Drive Torque</b>	21 Kg/cm minimum
<b>Plating</b>	Green Ruspert finish
